### *Greetings!*

Water conservation is very important to our economy and to your business. To help preserve our groundwater supplies, the Upper San Pedro Partnership is introducing a free Sloan Upper Cut Dual-Flushometer retrofit program. It is simply the replacement of the silver handle on flushometer valve assemblies with a special green handle, and takes minutes to install. The handles are distinctive with a green microbial coating, and when pulled up for liquid flushes use 1.28 gallons as a standard flush. The user pushes the handle down for a full flush.



You are receiving this letter because you may have some candidate toilets in your facility and we request your participation in this free program.

Eligible toilets are 1.6 gallons per flush (gpf) flushometer toilets (the use number is stamped behind the seat or LC is stamped on the valve assembly). All 1.6 gpf toilets located in women's restrooms are eligible, 1.6 gpf toilets in men's handicap stalls, and all 1.6 gpf toilets in men's restrooms without urinals.

To participate:

1. Contact Rebecca Dailous, at [rebecca.dailous@arizona.edu](mailto:rebecca.dailous@arizona.edu), 458-8278 x 2150. Rebecca will schedule a visit and ask you a few restroom usage questions for data collection.
2. Count the number of eligible toilets in your facility.
3. Agree to have your maintenance staff install the retrofits and informational signs in the toilet stalls (all provided) within 30 days of receiving the valve handles.
4. Contact Rebecca when the handles are installed for a check-back visit.
5. Tell your employees that your business has participated in this retrofit program, and encourage them to use the handles correctly by reading the signs posted in the toilet stalls.
